

EKETAHUNA SCHOOL - 'FUN RUN'

Wednesday 10th June at 11:00am @ Eketahuna Golf Club

We are running this event under the Covid-19 ALert Level 2 Guidelines and expect all those attending to adhere to procedures below which have been put in place to ensure everyone's health and well being.

Timetable for the day:

- We have organised buses to transport children down to the Ekethuna Golf Club in the order they will run
- The first 'run' is at 11:15am
- All children will be bussed back to school before the normal home time bell rings.

Order of Runs:

- Years 8, 7 and 6 - Will have staggered starts from 11.15am through to 11.45pm
- Years 2, 1 and 0 - Will have staggered starts from 12.00pm through to 12.20pm
- Years 5, 4 and 3 - Will have staggered starts from 12.20pm through to 1.00pm



If time allows, other fun activities such as pillow case racing, hula-hoop racing and egg and spoon races will happen at the completion of the official 'Fun Run'.

Children will need:

- A change of clothes as they can become very dirty and cold
- Suitable footwear because, for part of the course the children will be running on stones and branches
- Morning tea and lunch as usual, with lots of water in a named drink bottle
- Warm clothes to wear before and after the race

(Please note: If children are too sick to run on the day we ask that they have a signed note or give Mrs Drysdale a call at the office. If appropriate, as the children will be spending part of the day outside, they will be better off at home if they are unwell.)

Supporters:

- Supporters are welcome to watch the children run; however, we will be adhering to Level 2 Covid-19 rules. Therefore, whilst you will be there to cheer and support the children, there will be no physical contact at the event. Furthermore, there will be a partitioned area for parents / supporters, where you must maintain 1 metre of physical distancing.
- All supporters will need to sign a "register of attendance" with Denise Drysdale for Covid-19 records.
- You be required to sign in on arrival and again on departure
- If you feel any uncertainty in having your child attend this event for safety reasons, i.e. Covid-19, then you're more than welcome to keep your child at home for the day.
- Parking is available at the Golf Course.

Postponement:

- A decision will be made at 9.00am on the day if the 'Fun Run' is to be postponed.
- If the day is postponed, we will place a notice on our school Facebook page to let you know.
- If a postponement does occur, we will hold the event on the following day - Thursday 11th June.

Home Time:

We realise that after each student has completed their run, parents and caregivers may wish to take them home, especially if the day is cold and children are wet. Parents/Caregivers will need to inform Mrs Drysdale, at the registration table, before taking children home so that we know where they are. THIS IS VERY IMPORTANT as the school is responsible for them.

Important: **Under no circumstances are students allowed to go home with friends.**
