<p>Sand Saucer Creation: Children will need to bring a saucer, flowers, little toys or objects they wish to display with the ‘theme’ of their saucer- e.g a farm, fairy garden etc. Sand will be supplied.</p> <p>Petal Picture: Children will need to bring a selection of flowers and leaves.</p> <p>Lamb Mosaic: All materials will be supplied.</p> <p>Spring Flower Bottle: Children will need to bring a clear plastic bottle (not green or brown) a selection of flowers, feathers & leaves.</p>	<p>Decorated Cup Cakes: Children need to bring 6 plain cupcakes and decorations. Icing sugar, food colouring and plates provided.</p> <p>Spring Show Cards: All materials will be supplied.</p> <p>Scarecrow at School: Children will need to bring in old clothing, straw, hay, etc to make and decorate their Scarecrow.</p> <p>String Art: All materials will be supplied.</p>	<p>Stained Glass Painting: All materials will be supplied.</p> <p>Bubble Painting: Children will need to bring a small bottle of bubble solution.</p> <p>Rainbow Paper Plate Weaving: Children will need to bring scraps of bright coloured wool/yarn.</p> <p>Salad Spinner Pictures: All materials will be supplied.</p>

<p>Floral Arrangement in Unusual Container: Children bring an unusual container and flowers/ foliage to put together in a creative way.</p> <p>Miniature Scene: Bring a tray / container to create a scene based on your favourite children’s story book. Please bring all items needed to create your scene, eg flowers, sticks, foliage, figures etc.</p> <p>Decorated Cupcakes / Biscuits: Children need to bring 6 plain cupcakes/biscuits and decorations. Icing sugar, food colouring and plates will be provided.</p> <p>Pet Rocks: Rocks and paint will be supplied.</p>	<p>3D Nature Art: Children need to bring unique stones, twigs, deer/ rabbit or possum skins, antlers, moss etc</p> <p>Tiny Houses: Children need to bring figurines, tiny home furniture etc. All house construction material will be supplied.</p> <p>Tote Tray Islands: Children will need to bring in all items needed to create their island scene, eg flowers, sticks, foliage, figures etc.</p> <p>Pūtara Mai Mai Scene: Setting a real life maimai so children will need to bring camo nets, decoys, gumboots, old cookers or billies, old tin / corrugated iron, old pictures or photos, duck callers etc</p>
